What Position Am I running For?

The Students' Union is a **not-for-profit organization** governed by a **Board of Directors**. The elected **President and Chief Executive Officer (CEO)** leads the operation of the organization and manages a staff team comprised of paid employees and volunteers. The President and CEO is tasked with developing programming and initiatives that advance the Mission, Vision, and Guiding Principles of the Students' Union. The Students' Union aims to provide undergraduate students with a holistic university experience where students benefit from:

- An organization that advocates for an affordable, accessible, and high quality academic experience.
- A safe, sustainable, and empowering environment.
- Diverse and inclusive social interaction.
- Products and services that cater to the financial needs of students.

Once elected, the incoming President and CEO hires an Executive Leadership Team that will also serve a one-year term. Collectively this team represents the student-driven organizational emphasis of the Students' Union.

In conjunction with the Executive Director who oversees the continuing staff team, the President and CEO will lead the creation of an annual plan early in their term. **As you consider your campaign platform**, this annual plan model serves as a useful guide for conceptualizing what projects, initiatives, and programming you intend to pursue if elected. This often requires finding a balance between aspirational change and practical problem solving.

The specific full-time **job-related duties** of the President and CEO include:

- Acting as the official Students' Union spokesperson and advocate.
- Demonstrating operational and financial compliance to organizational standards and best practices established by the Board of Directors, the Students' Union bylaws, and all policies and regulations of the corporation.
- Managing a staff team.
- Overseeing the Students' Union financial management in conjunction with the Executive Director.
- Overseeing the Students' Union business operations in conjunction with the Executive Director.
- Membership on a variety of Students' Union and Wilfrid Laurier University committees.
- Participating in municipal, provincial, and federal stakeholder relations activities.

- **Voting Days** – January 27, 2026, at 8:00am to January 29, 2026, at 8:00pm.
- **Annual Meeting & Results Night** – January 29, 2026, at 9:00pm.

Expenditures and Reimbursements:

Candidates for Students' Union President and CEO are limited to expenses, sponsorships, and gifts-in-kind totalling **\$700**. A maximum of **3 trips** between the Brantford and Waterloo campus are eligible for an additional mileage reimbursement.

The Chief Returning Officer or their designate must approve in advance all promotional materials used for campaigning, regardless of the medium.

Candidates will be reimbursed for 100% of approved campaign expenses, unless the maximum allowable limit is surpassed.

Candidates are required to submit receipts in order for campaign materials to be reimbursed.

Candidates who wish to utilize posters on campus for campaigning are limited to **50** copies (You are responsible for following Laurier's poster policy and for removing all posters following the election).

All social media platforms (accounts) intended for campaigning and promotional use must be declared, approved, and registered with the Chief Returning Officer, or their designate prior to use.

****It is your responsibility to review the 2026 Election Policy in detail to understand all campaigning and expenditure guidelines, and the process for demerits and appeals****

Frequently Asked Questions

Is the Students' Union a student government?

No, the Students' Union is a non-profit organization with a membership that includes all Wilfrid Laurier Undergraduate students.

Is the President and CEO role full-time?

Yes, the President and CEO is a full-time one-year position with an expectation to work 40 hours a week commencing May 1st following election and concluding April 30th the following year. The traditional hours of operation of the Students' Union are between 8:30am and 4:30pm, Monday to Friday, with regular responsibilities outside of those standard office hours.

Who can run for Students' Union President and CEO?

All students registered in an undergraduate program at Wilfrid Laurier University are eligible to run, however because it's a full-time position most individuals do so in their last term of study.

Can I run for more than one position?

If you are running for Students' Union President & CEO you are not permitted to also run for the Board of Directors.

Can individuals who are interested in being elected President and CEO speak with current Students' Union staff members?

Yes, Students' Union staff members are generally available to chat with you about their roles.

Does the President-Elect receive training prior to starting the role?

Yes, the President-Elect will participate in an extensive transition period in the months leading up to the May 1st start.

Does the President-Elect choose their executive team members?

The President-Elect will participate in an extensive hiring process that follows human resources best practices.

How does voting work?

Voting is conducted by electronic ballot with your Laurier student credentials.

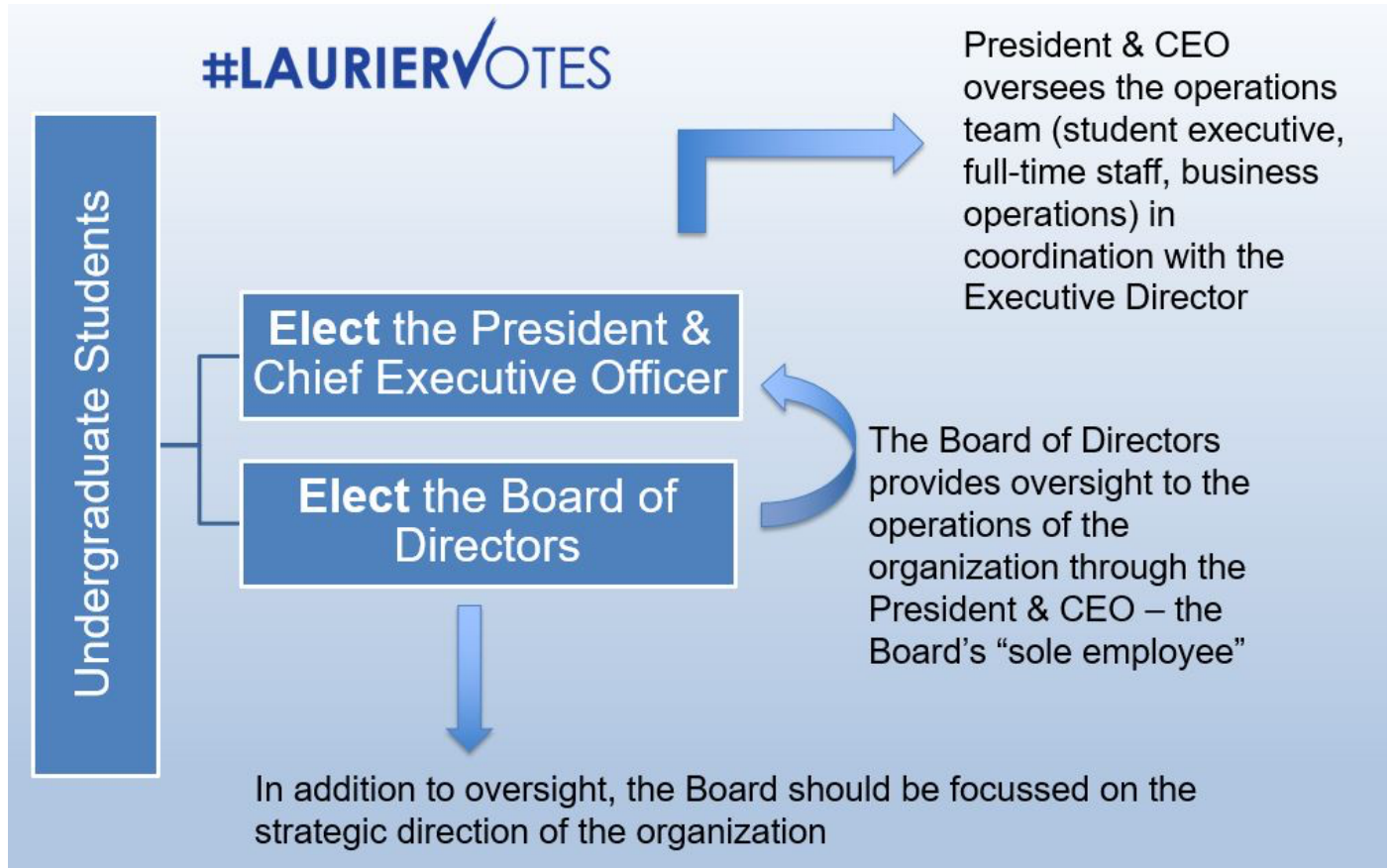
What is a “CRO”?

The Chief Returning Officer (CRO) oversees the general conduct and execution of the elections on behalf of the Students' Union Board of Directors.

What is the purpose of the Board of Directors?

The Board of Directors is the Students' Union's governance body, based on [Policy Governance](#) system (the Carver Model). The role of the governing body is to:

- Represent the interests of the undergraduate students at Laurier.
- Determine the overall strategic purpose and value of the Students' Union.
- Monitor the performance of the organization through the President & CEO as instructed by the guidelines outlined in the Students' Union Policy Manual.
- Self-monitor the Board's own performance and adherence to the governance practices set out in the Policy Manual.
- Continually assess the suitability of the Policy Manual as a set of operating instructions provided to the President and CEO as the sole representative of the operations team, and the Board for its own self-governance.
